

## LESSON FROM THE SECOND PSALMS

Scripture: Psalms 2

### Introduction:

- A. This Psalm reads almost like a News Paper.
- B. Preachers have for generations used this Psalm to show how near they thought the coming of the Lord was.
- C. Because of its content it should hold much practical good for us.

### I. LEARN WHAT IS THE GENERAL ATTITUDE OF THIS WORLD TO GOD AND HIS WORD. vs. 1-3

- A. The nations rage.  
Why are the nations in an uproar?
- B. The people plot a vain (empty) thing  
The people utter folly
- C. The kings of the earth set themselves against the Lord and against His anointed One.  
The kings of the earth take their stand against...
- D. The rulers take counsel against the Lord and His Anointed One—the Christ.  
The rulers plot and conspire against...
- E. All these say," Let us break their bands asunder and cast away their cords from us." These recognize God to exist and to have control over them...They plot to overthrow God and the Christ...
- F. In all this we see how bad conditions on earth will be before the coming of the Lord. Total rebellion...

### II. LEARN WHAT IS GOD'S ATTITUDE TOWARD THE REBELLION OF HIS CREATION. vs.4-6

- A. God shall laugh at the planned rebellion.  
He shall laugh at their threats ...laugh them to scorn.
- B. God shall have them in derision.  
He shall make sport of them ...mock them.. (Elijah and the prophets of Baal on Mt. Carmel)
- C. God shall speak to them in His wrath.. angrily... indignation.
- D. God shall vex them in His sore displeasure.  
Confound them in His hot displeasure.  
In a rage He shall strike them in panic.  
In His fury, He will terrify them. Rev. 6:12-17
- E. God sets His on King upon His holy hill of Zion.

### III. LEARN HOW COMPLETE WILL BE OUR LORD'S CONTROL OVER THIS EARTH. vs. 7-9

- A. The nations, the people, the rulers, the kings shall be given to the Son, Jesus Christ, as His inheritance and He shall possess the whole earth. vs. 7,8
- B. Jesus Christ shall break the rebels with a rod of iron and dash them to pieces as a potter's vessel.
  - 1. There will be no more nations ...The kingdoms of this world shall become the kingdom of our God.
  - 2. The Lord shall rule with a rod of iron. Rev. 19:15

### IV. LEARN WHAT IS THE ONLY WISE THING TO DO IN THE LIGHT OF THESE TRUTHS. vs. 10-12

- A. Be wise accept instructions from the Lord ...Follow His Word, the Bible. v. 10
- B. Serve the Lord with fear...reverence. v.11
- C. Kiss the Son ...make up with the Chosen One lest you perish...
  - 1. Repent
  - 2. Trust
- D. Rejoice and be happy that you have won the victory over sin and self and Satan.
