Why do we worship? And how do we know if we are practicing "True Worship"? We can find these answers scattered throughout scripture. We can also find flawed humans with many "opinions" on how we should worship and why we should only be singing from the hymnal, praise songs, or that we should definitely just do whatever Chris Tomlin does. We as believers know that our compass should always be the Bible so lets take a look at a few verses and what those verses tell us about our reasons we should worship the perfect and Holy God. We worship because God created us to worship him, and He alone is worthy of our praise and adoration(John 4:23, Deuteronomy 10:21) The style in which we praise has long been debated in churches around the globe. However more important than the style of worship we bring is figuring out where our worship comes from. It should be coming from a place of reverence, humility, honor, adoration, zeal, and it needs to be genuine (Psalm 100:1-5, Hebrews 12:28-29) Being a young worship leader myself I know that I still have much to learn about our God and the way we worship him in all of His glory and I leave you with this last encouragement, do not let your worship be dictated by preference, setting, circumstance, or any other worldly thing. But worship because He is worthy to be praised!
