## THE QUESTION OF ALL QUESTIONS

John 9:35

Intro: Jesus asked this man a soul-searching question, "Dost thou believe on the Son of God?" He did this in order to bring comfort and assurance to the man. It is best when a man gets in trouble that he look at his own relationship with God!

## I. THIS IS A QUESTION THAT NEEDS TO BE ASKED OF EVERY MAN!

- A. Our relationship with Christ must not be taken for granted.
  - 1. This blind man had been scrupulously obedient, yet Christ asked, "Dost thou believe in the Son of God?"
  - 2. This man, no doubt, had a great experience, a very remarkable experience, yet the question was asked.
  - 3. In addition to physical sight he had received, he also exercised a certain amount of faith and yet Christ still asked the question.
  - 4. He had spoken out bravely for Christ!
    - a. One of his hearers said, "He spoken like a Trojan!"
    - b. He stood up bravely for this One Who had healed him.
    - c. And yet Christ asked, "Dost thou believe on the Son of God?"
  - 5. He had suffered for Christ!
    - a. You may have been laughed at, scorned, ridiculed for Christ.
    - b. But "dost thou believe in the Son of God?"

NOTE: The question must be asked of everyone, because many try to be a Christian without having Christ. This type of person admires preachers who preach that you can be a
