

THE QUESTION OF ALL QUESTIONS

John 9:35

Intro: Jesus asked this man a soul-searching question, "*Dost thou believe on the Son of God?*" He did this in order to bring comfort and assurance to the man. It is best when a man gets in trouble that he look at his own relationship with God!

I. THIS IS A QUESTION THAT NEEDS TO BE ASKED OF EVERY MAN!

A. Our relationship with Christ must not be taken for granted.

1. This blind man had been scrupulously obedient, yet Christ asked, "*Dost thou believe in the Son of God?*"
2. This man, no doubt, had a great experience, a very remarkable experience, yet the question was asked.
3. In addition to physical sight he had received, he also exercised a certain amount of faith and yet Christ still asked the question.
4. He had spoken out bravely for Christ!
 - a. One of his hearers said, "*He spoken like a Trojan!*"
 - b. He stood up bravely for this One Who had healed him.
 - c. And yet Christ asked, "*Dost thou believe on the Son of God?*"
5. He had suffered for Christ!
 - a. You may have been laughed at, scorned, ridiculed for Christ.
 - b. But "*dost thou believe in the Son of God?*"

NOTE; The question must be asked of everyone, because many try to be a Christian without having Christ. This type of person admires preachers who preach that you can be a
